This guide aims to give an overview of the different types of additional scholarships and funding options relevant to doctoral students already enrolled at BerGSAS who are scholarship holders or have a part-time position. Besides a short text explaining each of the various types, we also supply you with a list for each category, which you can navigate by using Ctrl/Strg + left click on the names in the table of contents.

Please note that you should always talk to the institution currently financing you first, in order to avoid breaking their rules, and because most already offer the types of funding listed here. This overview does not include funding options that are only open to students that already hold scholarships by specific institutions. At least in principle (restrictions on gender, academic performance, financial status, university, field and more apply) all options listed here are open to everyone.

Also not covered here are full doctoral scholarships (for more information you may take a look at the HU “financing your doctorate” brochure [210719financing-your-doctorate.pdf](#), or the various scholarship databases), PreDoc scholarships which serve to help students develop their project in the first place (e.g. [PreDoc scholarships • Berliner Antike-Kolleg](#)).

Finalisation Scholarships “Abschlussförderung”

The following resources might be of use to you, if your doctoral scholarship has run out, or your work contract has expired, but you have yet to finish your doctoral dissertation.

There are a number of options, which we would like to inform you about. Please note that most of these institutions have high requirements regarding the quality of your doctoral dissertation and final grade of your master’s degree. Often you will also be required to convincingly lay out why you were unable to complete your doctoral project in the initial time frame. Further restrictions based on e.g., gender, parental status, university, previous funding and more might apply.

Please always speak to the institution currently financing you first, to see if an extension is possible. Inform yourself in good time.

Disclaimer: This overview does not assert to cover all available forms of Abschlussförderung, it merely aims to give an overview of the most common options. Furthermore, we cannot guarantee that the dates and numbers listed here, are correct.

Deutscher Akademikerinnenbund: Stipendium

Amount: 500 € per month

Duration: up to one year

Criteria: only for women, above average performance

Deadlines: August

Notes: only 2 scholarships per cycle, can be paired with another scholarship that grants less than 500 € per month; Website only in German

Elsa-Neumann Scholarship Program: Scholarship for the completion of a doctorate

Amount: 1.350 € per month, plus a lump sum of 100 € for research expenses. In addition, scholarship recipients can apply for family allowance and refunds for travel expenses

Duration: up to one year

Criteria: **no previous public funding** (this includes scholarships by publicly funded private institutions AND part-time employment as a research assistant etc.), academic performance well above average, students from all Berlin universities

Deadlines: April/November for the respective funding periods

Notes: make sure to apply to the correct scholarship, as they also offer a 3-year full-time scholarship.

Fazit Stiftung: Promotionsstipendium

Duration: up to 24 months

Criteria: applicants cannot be older than 28 years at the start of the dissertation, applicants must lay out why other funding or private savings are not an option.

Deadlines: applications are always open, hand in your applications 3-4 months before the start of the desired funding period

Notes: Website only in German; this scholarship is not limited to a certain phase of your dissertation project

Freie Universität Berlin: Grant for the successful graduation of study

Criteria: last 12 months of your studies; aimed at students in need, only FU Students

Notes: First come, first served basis – apply as soon as the application process opens!

Hildegardis Verein: Loans for female students

Amount: 250 € or 500 € per month, as an interest-free **loan**

Duration: no limit, up to 10.000 € in total

Criteria: only for women, all universities

Deadlines: June 30th December 31st respectively

Notes: the loan can also be applied for at an earlier stage of your studies

Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin: Central Women's Representative Completion Scholarship

Duration: up to 9 months

Criteria: only HU students, only for women, excellent academic performance, only if extension can be explained by factors such as care-work, parenthood, class-based issues etc.

Deadlines: applications are always open

Notes: If you finish your thesis within these nine months, you have the opportunity to apply for an additional scholarship covering the time until your defence.

Stiftung Bildung und Wissenschaft: Promotionsabschluss-Stipendium

Duration: up to one year

Criteria: only students of History and Literature, all universities

Deadlines: 15th of January

Notes: the scholarship seems to be aimed primarily at projects dealing with contemporary history and German literature. Please confirm with the foundation, if they would consider your project.

Duration: 3 years + 6 months extension, up to 4,5 years for students with children (any previous funding is subtracted from this period)

Criteria: top 10% of your course, high engagement in and outside of university

Notes: this is not an “Abschlussförderung” but you can switch to this scholarship, if it offers a longer funding period than your current one (Of course any previous funding period is subtracted) , Up to 10 hours of work in research/academia on the side are permitted.

Printing Cost Subsidies “Druckkostenzuschüsse”

In Germany students are required to publish their doctoral dissertation before they can carry the “Doktor” Title. Depending on your programme regulations “Studienordnung” you may have the following options: Publication with an accredited publisher (e.g., print, print on-demand, open access), self-publication (this can be as simple as printing it in a copy shop), Publication on Microfilm, or upload to the online repository of your university. All but the last option usually come with certain costs, that can reach into the thousands depending on the number of copies required, the page count, and other factors such as colour and number of illustrations. To help you with this, many scholarships (including Finalisation Scholarships) offer financial support. At times having participated in a project or having received smaller previous grants can be enough to qualify. On the contrary all printing cost subsidies listed here, are not exclusive to holders of specific scholarships. In case the fund is limited to electronic (open access) publications, the money can often be used for Editing/Proofreading fees. Almost all printing cost subsidy grants require a quote or contract by a publisher, but at the same time printing should not have started before the application is accepted.

The BerGSAS occasionally offers Seminars that provide more information regarding publishing your dissertation.

Travel Grants / Short-Term Fellowships

As part of your dissertation project, it might be necessary for you to travel, be it to excavation sites and archives or symposia, workshops and conferences. To help you cover the costs, various institutions offer travel grants, of varying amounts and under different conditions.

Some of the listed opportunities are Fellowships which may come with the obligation to participate and stay (free of charge) at a specific research institution, while others are more flexible. The Name of the Program does not necessarily point towards either type. For more information, read the “criteria” section of each list item.

As with the other types of additional funding, it is always best to inform yourself about such possibilities at your current and past financing institutions first, as many of the best and most attainable grants are offered only internally.

The opportunities listed here are, at least in principle, open to anyone. Please note that you should always safeguard the receipts of all your incurred costs.
