"The Parting of the Ways between Jews and Christians in Antioch in 386/7 CE:

What John Chrysostom tells us and what he doesn't tell us"

Abstract: John Chrysostom's sermons *Against the Jews* (or *Against the Judaizers*) reveals his perspective very clearly: Christians should not associate with, or show respect for, Jews and Judaism. But many Christians in his community did associate with, and show respect for, Jews and Judaism, and John upbraids them severely. But in spite of himself John reveals something of the motivations and self-understanding of his opponents. Their conception of the boundary between Jews and Christians clearly differed from his.
